In order to register a resident student, the parent, court-appointed legal guardian, military guardian or the student shall provide proof of residency or proof that a waiver has been requested as outlined below and shall complete all admission requirements as determined by Board policies, rules and procedures. Resident students who cannot provide adequate proof of residency may request a waiver in accordance with state law (see Board policy JECA). Students who do not meet the residency requirements may apply for admission in accordance with state law regarding admission of nonresident students (see Board policy JECB).

At least one (1) of the following criteria shall be used in determining student residency:

1. The student physically resides and is domiciled in the district. The domicile of a minor child shall be the domicile of a parent, military guardian or court-appointed legal guardian. A "power of attorney" document alone is insufficient to satisfy the "court-appointed legal guardian" requirement.
2. The student is otherwise proven to be legally domiciled within the district.

In order to satisfy the district's residency requirements, the student, parent, military guardian or court-appointed legal guardian must provide one (1) or more of the following items as proof of residency:
